How we organize the trips: each sailing trip runs for a week from Saturday to Saturday. The trip sets off from the island of Mali Losinj in the northern Adriatic Sea (Croatia). The simplest way of getting there is to fly from London to Pula with RyanAir, or to Rijeka airport (located in the island of Krk) with EasyJet. The earlier you book, the greater your chance of getting a cheap flight.

I will be waiting for you on the boat in the harbour of Mali Losinj. We can then discuss the itinerary of our trip, depending on the weather and your wishes. Early afternoon we set sail, and from then on until the following Saturday the pleasures of sailing are all ours! On board there are 4 cabins, each with a double bed. So what you rent is a berth (the bed) in a cabin. Clearly, it costs correspondingly more for a single person to rent a double-bed cabin for him/herself alone.

The prices vary according to the season and depend on the overall number of crew. The total price for chartering the boat is divided among the crew.

I will always make sure there is a maximum of 7 people (including me!) sailing with the boat, so everyone has plenty of room to enjoy the trip in comfort.

Sharing on-board expenses:

Day-to-day expenses such as fuel, catering or (when required) harbour charges are paid from a shared "kitty". If the fund of petty cash runs low, it is topped up by crew members.

The skipper is exempt from paying into the fund.

On some evenings we could visit a "Konoba", a local tavern, on others we might barbecue fish we have caught ourselves or bought on the market. For this, everyone on board pays his/her own way.

The entire crew shares the charges for the skipper's services of 120 E uro per day.

Lightweight bedding is provided on board the boat. For trips lasting longer than 7 days a second set of bedding is available.

Accident insurance for all participants as well as a deposit and liability insurance for the skipper are included in the price of the trip.
